

Discover Izu - Jogasaki Walking Tour

A walk along the beautiful Jogasaki coast is a perfect introduction to Izu. You'll enjoy panoramic views of the Sagami Bay and the Izu islands. You'll learn about Izu's unique local history and its role in Japan's opening to the West. You'll discover Izu's unique plant and animal life, and you will learn about Izu's amazing geology as you walk along a coastline created by a lava flow from nearby Mt. Omuro.

Our walk will begin near Boranaya, a historical fishing hut built 1626. We will walk south along the Jogasaki Picnical Course, and end near the Kadowaki Light House.
